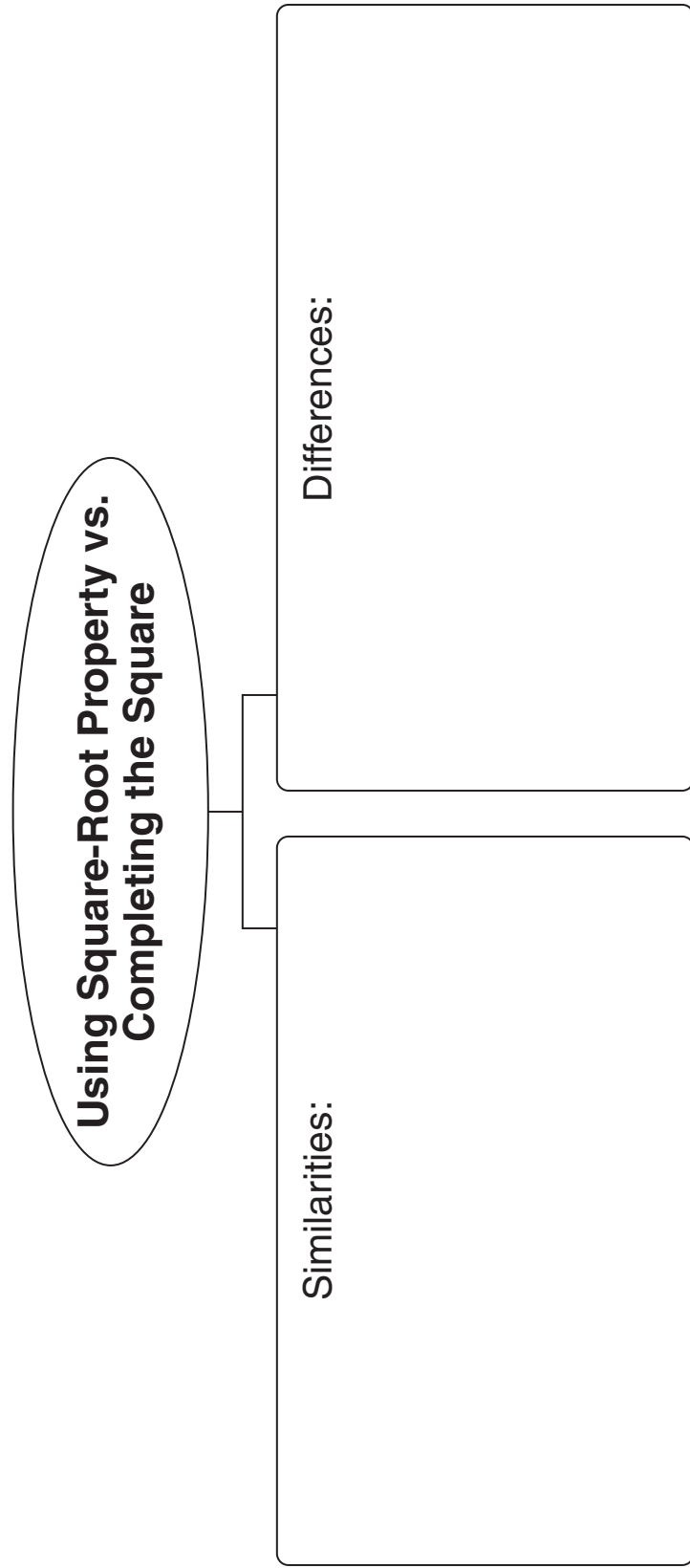


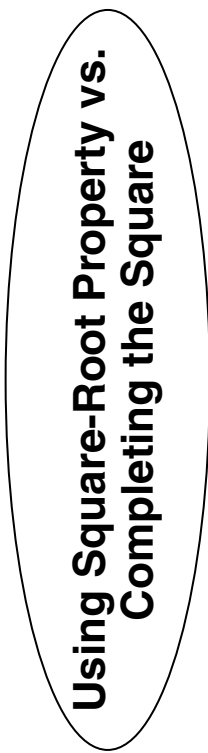

5. Get Organized Compare and contrast two methods of solving quadratic equations. (p. 344).



Similarities:
Both involve taking the square root of each side of an equation. Both may involve writing an expression as a binomial squared.

Differences:
The Square-Root Property is useful for expressions that are perfect squares. Completing the square is useful for expressions that are not perfect squares.
